

SAFETY POLICY:

Yousra Road Building and Construction Company (YRBCC) is committed to maintaining the highest standards of health, safety, and environmental care across all of its operations. It is our policy to ensure, as far as is reasonably practicable, that all employees, subcontractors, and others involved in our projects work in a safe environment, with safe methods of operation, and that the health and safety risks inherent in our activities are minimized through careful planning, leadership, and ongoing risk assessment.

Key Commitments:

 Health and Safety Arrangements YRBCC will provide clear, structured arrangements for health and safety across all project phases, including planning, organization, leadership, and control.



We will also regularly monitor, review, and report on health and safety practices. These arrangements ensure that potential hazards are identified and mitigated in advance, keeping all personnel safe throughout the construction process.

- 2. **Cooperation and Communication** YRBCC acknowledges the importance of effective communication and collaboration between all stakeholders. We will ensure that there is coordination and the exchange of vital safety information between subcontractors and all other parties involved in our projects. This cooperation fosters a shared understanding of safety protocols and ensures everyone is working toward the common goal of safety on site.
- 3. **Training and Information** We will provide all necessary health and safety training, as well as ongoing education to employees at every level. This training will be tailored to individual roles, risk assessments, and the specific health and safety requirements of the tasks being performed. YRBCC believes that by continuously educating our workforce, we can build a culture of safety, where individuals are aware of the risks and how to avoid them.
- 4. **Emergency Procedures** YRBCC will establish clear emergency response procedures for any situation involving imminent or serious danger. We will implement specific safety protocols for working in hazardous areas, ensuring that personnel are aware of what to do in the event of an emergency, including evacuation procedures, first aid measures, and communication protocols. Emergency drills will also be conducted regularly to ensure preparedness.
- 5. **Health Surveillance** Where required by legislation or determined necessary by our risk assessments, YRBCC will provide health surveillance to monitor the well-being of our employees. This may include regular medical examinations or monitoring for specific hazards such as exposure to noise, dust, or hazardous substances. SECURITY POLICY:-

Yousra Road Building and Construction Company (YRBCC) prioritizes stringent security measures to ensure the safety of personnel, materials, and equipment at project sites. To





comply with security protocols, YRBCC will coordinate closely with site security management to facilitate the smooth access of personnel, vehicles, and construction materials. This coordination includes applying for photo identification badges for all working staff, which will be issued by site security management to ensure proper identification and monitoring.

Complete and accurate information for each employee, including name, father's name, ethnicity, full address, and emergency contact details, will be submitted to security management. No worker or staff member is permitted to deviate from designated project areas. Unauthorized movement will result in the immediate removal of the individual from the site. Additionally, no photography or sketching of unrelated areas is allowed, and only tools and equipment necessary for the project will be mobilized.

YRBCC will adhere to designated working hours, with operations commencing at 8:00 AM and continuing until 12:30 PM, followed by a one-hour lunch break. Work will then resume from 1:30 PM to 4:30 PM. Strict body and vehicle searches will be conducted at entry points to ensure the security of the site. All personnel and vehicles must undergo these checks to gain access, reinforcing safety and security throughout the project's duration. These measures reflect YRBCC's commitment to maintaining a secure and compliant work environment.




